



## **Intro to 4 Weeks With Jesus**

At MVCC, we want to help make this Easter Season a very special one. For that reason we have put together this devotional workbook for you. Our challenge to you over these four weeks is to read through the book of Luke two times, memorize six verses, and complete four spiritual assessments. We also want to encourage you to take notes from every message.

As you embark on reading through the gospel of Luke, keep in mind that God not only wants you to learn about Jesus, but to become more like Him. So as you "look at Jesus," look also at yourself, and ask yourself, "in what way can I become more like him?" There are three questions we would like you to ask yourself as you read the gospel of Luke. These are:

1. What is God teaching me about Jesus through His Word?
2. What is God saying to me about my heart as I "look at Jesus' heart?"
3. Who is God calling me to love and/or serve this week the way Jesus would?

In this devotional we will provide a place where you can ask these questions and write down those answers. This will take place every Thursday as you complete the Spiritual Assessment that is provided for you. Please do this and I am confident it will GREATLY enhance your "look at Jesus."
